### Clubs

Team sports practice once a week after school & compete on Saturdays. Focus is on participation & sportsmanship. Registration is open to any high school student residing within MMSD & not playing on the WIAA team in the same season.

## <u>Fees</u>

In school MSCR clubs are free. Extramural sports has a fee which varies. Traveling clubs & special events have fees associated with the cost of admission. MSCR offers scholarships for students who qualify for free or reduced lunch.
